This contract sets out the terms on which we undertake to provide an inspection service on machinery and plant (hereafter referred to simply as **plant**).



The proposal and any other information in addition to or in substitution for the proposal, supplied to **NFU Mutual** by or on behalf of the client, are the basis of this contract.

The client having agreed to pay the premium, **NFU Mutual** will provide **plant** inspections under the terms of this contract.

Definitions

Some words have a special meaning wherever they appear and their definitions are as follows.

Period of Contract

The period from the effective date until noon on the expiry date or the cancellation date if earlier. The effective date and expiry date are stated in the schedule. The procedures for cancelling the contract earlier than the expiry date are set out below.

Plant

The plant described in the schedule, excluding any chimneys, masonry, brickwork, foundations or supporting structures, unless these are specified in the schedule.

Unless otherwise agreed, inspections of steam boilers will be of the pressure system defined in the written scheme of examination only and inspections of hot water heating installations will only examine the boiler (excluding the firing apparatus) and any part of the installation which is defined as a pressure system requiring statutory inspections.

Special Plant Definitions

Hot Water Heating Installation

The hot water heating boiler, it's firing apparatus including any photoelectric cell and connected pipes, radiators, hot water storage cylinders, calorifiers, circulating pumps (including shut pumps) and their motors, thermionic valves, motorised valves in oil pipes, oil filters (including motors), oil pre-heaters, oil level indicators and/or alarms and heaters in oil pipes and tanks.

Lifting tackle

Chains, ropes, slings hooks, shackles or eyebolts not forming an integral part of lifting plant by means of which a load or appliance can be attached to the hook, shackle or other lifting gear which do form an intergral part of lifting plant.

Oil Burning Unit

The oil burner, it's driver motor, the oil pre-heater, tank heater, line heater, photo-electric cell, thermionic valve, oil tank level indicator and/or alm, motorised valve(s) on the oil pipeline, the oil filter (including motor) and fan.

Cancellation

NFU Mutual may cancel this contract by giving written notice to the client by recorded delivery to the client's last known address, such cancellation being effective 30 days after the notice is despatched.

If the client defaults under a credit agreement to pay the premium, the contract will cease in accordance with the conditions of the credit agreement unless **NFU Mutual** agrees otherwise in writing.

Plant Inspections

During the **period of contract**, the **plant** will be inspected by **NFU Mutual's** representatives who will supply reports to the client at a frequency determined by legal requirements or annually where there is no legal requirement.

The inspections will be periodical examinations of those parts of the **plant** which are accessible and have been sufficiently prepared for examination. The inspections and reports will comply with any relevant statutory requirements.

This contract does not include testing of **plant** or witnessing of testing.

The responsibility for meeting all statutory obligations to have **plant** inspected or tested remains with the client. The client is responsible for preparing any **plant** for inspection at their own expense, when **NFU Mutual's** representatives give advance notice that inspection is due. The client is also responsible for providing safe access to **plant** which is to be inspected.
