Classical Swine Fever

Closed herd

A herd into which no animals are introduced from an outside source, other than the occasional replacement boar, and which is not fed **swill or waste food**.

Ministry

The Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, the Scottish Executive Environmental Rural Affairs Department, the National Assembly for Wales and the Department of Agricultural and Rural Development for Northern Ireland or their legal successors.

Open herd

A herd into which animals can be introduced from an outside source and which is not fed **swill or waste food**.

Swill or waste food

- a) any meat, any other part of the carcase of any livestock or poultry or any product derived therefrom, hatchery waste, eggs or eggshells
- b) any broken or waste foodstuffs (including table or kitchen refuse, scraps or waste),

but not including meal manufactured from protein originating from animals or poultry.

Swill or waste food fed herd

A herd (closed or open) which is at any time fed with **swill or waste food** which has been processed by being maintained at a temperature of at least 100 degrees Centigrade (212 degrees Fahrenheit) for a minimum of 60 minutes

Cover

If any **livestock insured** are slaughtered by or on behalf of the **Ministry** as a result of the existence of classical swine fever being confirmed by the **Ministry** during the **period of insurance**, **NFU Mutual** will pay to the Insured the **insured percentage** of the **Ministry** compensation paid to him in respect of such livestock.

Provided that

- 1) no payment will be made for animals slaughtered as a result of an outbreak of classical swine fever confirmed within 21 days after the **section operative date**

2) no payment will be made where **swill or waste food** has been fed to the animals without it being previously processed by being maintained at a temperature of at least 100 degrees Centigrade (212 degrees Fahrenheit) for a minimum of 60 minutes

3) **NFU Mutual's** liability during the **period of insurance** (including any amount payable under cover extensions) will not exceed

- a) in respect of each **item**, the **sum insured** on that **item**
- b) in all, the **total sum insured**.

Cover Extension

Livestock temporarily removed

Each **item** includes livestock as described in the **item** while temporarily at any situation

- a) for the purpose of attending agricultural shows
- b) for any other purposes, for a period not exceeding 7 consecutive days,

but remaining in Great Britain, Northern Ireland, the Isle of Man or the Channel Islands.

Special Conditions

1 Underinsurance

If, at the time of confirmation of classical swine fever giving rise to a claim under any **item**, the **total value** specified for such **item** is less than 75 per cent of the market value of all **livestock insured** by such **item**, **NFU Mutual** will be liable for only that proportion of the amount otherwise payable under such **item** that the **total value** specified bears to such market value.

2 Herd type

Cover under this section is granted on the basis of the **herd type**. If, at the time of a claim, it is found that, at any time during the 3 months prior to slaughter, the basis stated has not been complied with, **NFU Mutual's** liability will be reduced to that proportion of the amount otherwise payable that the rate of premium actually charged bears to the rate of premium which would have been charged had the insurance been issued on the correct basis.
